

Bodacious Bulldogs

Deposits and Puppies on Hold:

- 1) We ask for \$500.00 deposit per puppy. This is non-refundable (unless puppy dies or does not pass health exam before date of pick up).
- 2) Puppies can only be picked up when paid in full.
- 3) No refunds of any kind.

One Year Health Guarantee:

- 1) Seller believes this puppy to be in good health at the time of sale and certifies that Bulldog described herein has been properly vaccinated with its first set of shots and dewormings.
- 2) For this guarantee to become effective the Buyer(s) must have their puppy examined by a **licensed veterinarian** within 48 hours after receiving the puppy. Failure to do so will void this health guarantee. If the veterinarian finds that the said puppy is not in good health, they must state so in writing, detailing the findings. Buyer(s) must notify "Bodacious Bulldogs" **immediately**. Within 72 hours of purchase "Bodacious Bulldogs" has the right to have the dog re-examined by our own veterinarian. If the diagnosis is confirmed by our veterinarian, then "Bodacious Bulldogs" will resume the possession, if buyer(s) so chooses credit to another puppy.
- 3) All our puppies are examined by a licensed veterinarian, prior to going to their new homes.
- 4) "Bodacious Bulldogs" will send with the puppy a health record which will contain any medical treatment your puppy has received since he/she was born. (i.e., vaccines, worming)
- 5) "Bodacious Bulldogs" guarantees our puppies to be free from any **significant life threatening** diseases (i.e., heart, cancer...) for up to one year from time of birth, to original buyer(s). If puppy is transferred, sold, given to another party this guarantee is void. If a condition is found and proven in writing from a licensed veterinarian and substantiated by lab tests, and x-rays, confirmed by "Bodacious Bulldogs" veterinarian at buyer(s) expense, the puppy may then be returned to us for credit towards another puppy when one is available. The replacement puppy may be from different parents and/or bloodlines then from the original puppy. It must be of comparable bloodlines and price range.
- 6) "Bodacious Bulldogs" must be notified immediately upon the onset of any problem with the puppy. **NOTE:** minor breed related, treatable or correctable conditions or any condition that will go away or is considered to be a condition which puppy will likely out grow, are NOT covered. Buyer(s) are responsible for all vet bills incurred with said puppy along with transportation costs for its return.
 - a. We will provide the original buyer(s) of said puppy in case of death with a replacement puppy (when one is available). Only if all of the above is met.
 - b. If Buyer(s) chooses to replace puppy, the deceased puppy will need to be returned to us (on ice), along with all written information, X-rays, and/or lab work from a licensed veterinarian. This is the sole responsibility of the buyer(s).
 - c. Any and all veterinarian expenses incurred by the buyer(s) for any reason will **NOT** be our responsibility.
 - d. If ever a puppy needs to be returned to "Bodacious Bulldogs", it must be returned in sound condition, other than the specified problem found by the veterinarian, which will be the sole reason for the return of the puppy. All AKC papers, health records, and any other documentation must be returned with puppy.
 - e. **TERMINATION OF GUARANTEE** regardless: if said puppy has been bred, neutered, spayed, or has any signs of abuse what so ever. Also all of the puppy's vaccines, heartworm preventative, and worming records from a licensed veterinarian must be up to date. No Exceptions.
 - f. All puppies are sold with breeding rights unless otherwise specified. "Bodacious Bulldogs" will not guarantee that said puppy will be a proven breeder, or show quality.

Not Covered

- 1 Reimbursement for any veterinary expenses.
- 2 Reimbursement for any transportation/return.
- 3 Any injury or illness which could of occurred during transport.
- 4 Any condition which can be easily and permanently cured or corrected.
- 5 Any external or internal parasites. All puppies will most likely have internal parasites which can easily be treated with the proper wormers.
- 6 If your puppy doesn't get along with the other animals in your home.

NORMAL PROBLEMS THAT BULLDOGS MIGHT HAVE

Tear Stains: If your dog has white on his face around his eyes, over time you may find his face stained caused by the tears from the eyes. This can be due to the fact that bulldogs have big round eyes that water, entropian (explained below) or the lashes will irritate the eye off and on. To help reduce the stains you can fix the problem, clean the face daily. You will never get rid of the stain but you can disguise it with dog makeup.

Cherry Eye: This is the gland from the third eyelid that protrudes in the corner of the eye. It can be easily removed by your vet. It is not a major surgery. But you need a vet that knows how to correctly do it so they do not get dry eye.

Entropian: This is where the eyelashes have turned inwards and are rubbing on the eyes causing them to water more than normal. Sometimes it could just be a couple lashes causing the problem or all of them. This is also a simple procedure to correct. It should be corrected. If not it could cause scratches on the cornea leading to more expensive eye problems.

Elongated Soft Palate: All bulldogs have this due to the fact they have such smashed in faces, or brachycephalic-short noses. In most cases it causes nothing more than snoring, but in severe cases it can cause breathing difficulties, more so during exercise and over heating. This can be corrected surgically.

Itchy Skin: Some bulldogs have allergies to grass, carpet, or food.

Diet: I feed Royal Canine for bulldogs. I have found that my bullies do great on this and have had no allergies. Sometimes a bully may be required to be placed on a prescription diet only bought through your vet.

Demodex (mange): There are two forms of demodex: localized and generalized. These little mites live on all dogs and are controlled by the dog's immune system. Sometimes as the dog goes through puberty, and/or stress, the body can't keep up with population control and the mites start to take over. You will see patches of hair loss. This can be easily managed and treated by your veterinarian. The sooner you treat the better the outcome. **This is not covered by the guarantee.**

Yeast Build up: Bulldogs are prone to yeast in their face wrinkles, feet, base of tail. I recommend that the face wrinkles be cleaned with a baby wipe every other day. You can wash your bully every two weeks to help reduce the yeast build up as well.

Overheated: Bulldogs are EXTREMELY prone to overheating. Many bullies die each year due to being left out in the heat, in the car, or even in a house that gets too hot. Be very aware of the temperature in your area.

Worms: You want to keep your puppy/dog dewormed all year long. **Worms** can be passed on to people. (check with your vet for a deworming program).
